Re Swans Wraparound Care

Our wraparound care team in Swans are re-opening to children from Monday 8th March. The provision will operate from 7:30am to 6:00pm, Monday to Friday during term time.

Swans is open to all children to enable parents and carers to work, undertake education or training, attend a medical appointment, a medical need or attend a support group.

We are following the government guidance closely and our risk assessment can be found on our school website. You may also choose to read the government guidance [parents and carers of children attending out-of-school settings during the coronavirus \(COVID-19\) outbreak](#).

Whilst Swans is an integral part of our school, it is classed as a separate childcare provider. We must advise parents and carers that you should be limiting your use of multiple out-of-school settings, and should as far as possible only be sending your children to one in order to minimise mixing. If you use another out-of-school setting, please email deputy@godstone.surrey.sch.uk to inform us of the details so that we can ensure the correct measures are in place.

The children will be kept in their class bubbles where possible. However, to allow interaction between children they may also be allowed to socialize with other children in their early years, key stage one, lower key stage two or upper key stage two pod. They may also be grouped into sibling groups if this is more appropriate.

If you would like your child to attend Swans, please let us know what days you would like for breakfast and after school club as soon as possible via the Swans email: swans@godstone.surrey.sch.uk.

Swans will continue to be held in the school hall. In line with the whole school policy, please ensure only one parent or carer drops off and picks up.
