Location: The Sustainability Centre, Hampshire

Dates: Tuesday 20th February-Wednesday 21st February 2024

Duration: 2 days, 1 night

Cost: The approximate cost for this trip is expected to be between £110 and £125 per pupil. This cost includes accommodation, three meals a day (breakfast, lunch, dinner), and all activities and workshops conducted at The Sustainability Centre.

Payment Plan: Once we have final numbers, we will provide you with information regarding the available payment plan options to help spread the cost. We understand the financial responsibility associated with these trips and will work with you to ensure a manageable payment structure.

In order for us to move forward with the necessary arrangements and secure a place on the residential trip, please complete and return the attached interest form to the school office no later than **Thursday 19th October 2023** along with a £20 non-refundable deposit via Scopay. This will allow us to gauge the level of interest and determine final costs based on the number of children attending and if we have sufficient numbers to proceed with the trip.
