## **Re: 2025 - Year 5 Residential Trip: Juniper Hall – Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> to Friday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2025**

We are pleased to confirm the final costs for the two-night residential trip to Juniper Hall near Dorking.

The final cost will be £268.50 spread across seven monthly payments of £38.36 from October 2024 to April 2025. Please ensure the payments are paid by the first of each month. If you prefer to pay in fewer instalments then you are able to pay two or more months in advance on Scopay.

The cost of this trip includes a morning, afternoon and evening hands-on workshop on Wednesday and Thursday with a morning workshop on Friday. Accommodation is in shared rooms. Meals provided include dinner on Wednesday; breakfast, lunch and dinner on Thursday; and breakfast and lunch on Friday. Morning and afternoon snacks are also included. We ask that parents provide a packed lunch for the first day.

The workshops that we hope to take part in include shelter building; orienteering; a full day of fieldwork exploring a local river (travelling by coach to the river); using microscopes to explore invertebrates; music and stories around the campfire; and star gazing using iPads to explore constellations and learning about myths and legends linked to our solar system.

Juniper Hall is run by The Field Studies Council, an educational environmental charity that provide trips to study geography and science in amazing surroundings. Juniper Hall is a superb country house dating from the 17th century set in a peaceful wooded valley. It is situated in an unspoilt area of the chalk North Downs and at the edge of Box Hill, Surrey. Being in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, many amazing rivers, deciduous woodlands and grasslands can be found on the doorstep.

In order to keep costs as low as possible, parents will be asked to drop off and collect their children from Juniper Hall, Old London Rd, Mickleham, Surrey RH5 6DA. We expect these times to be approximately 9:30am on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> March and 1:00pm on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> March.
